Art. C3 Documentation

- C3.1 Documentation will be on Wednesday, 9th of July, at the Jordan Speed Center, between 2:00 pm – 3:30 pm.
- C3.2 For team entries, the team manager will have to do the documentation.
- C3.3 All entrants should have the following:
- Scrutineering Card
 - Driver competition license
 - Team Registration
 - Racing Visa (for international entrants)

Art. C4 Team Passes

- C4.1 Each entry will be given the following passes:

Private Entry

- 1 x Driver
- 2 x Mechanic
- 2 x Guest

Team Entry

- 1 x Driver (multiplied by number of drivers registered)
- 2 x Mechanic (multiplied by number of drivers registered)
- 2 x Guest (multiplied by number of drivers registered)
- 3 x Additional guest passes
- 1 x Team Manager
- 1 x Media Pass

- C4.2 Additional passes can be requested during documentation and will be charged for as following:

- Additional Mechanic : 10 JDs
- Additional Media : 20 JDs
- Additional Guest : 3 JDs

Art. C5 Prizes

- C4.1 Winners of the event will be rewarded with prizes as following:

Art. C6 Advertising

- C6.1 Advertising space will be as following:

- C6.2 Refusal to place the sponsor's stickers stated above is obliged to pay double entry fees.
- C6.3 The driver is responsible for the optional advertisements. If the driver starts with missing advertisements, he / she might be fined up to double the entry fees. Optional advertisements replacement can be bought from the promoter for 5 JODs.

Art. C7 Penalties

- C7.1 Any driver who does not comply with all safety regulations, track rules, championship regulations and any regulations or instructions of the officials of the race, shall inflict upon himself warnings and penalties that can lead to fines and can be up to exclusion from races and or the series.
- C7.2 Offenders will be issued warnings as follows:
- Warning flag while driving
 - Verbal warning
 - Written warning with penalty
- C7.3 Penalties include but are not limited to:
- Starting a race at the back of the grid
 - Deduction or cancellation of race or championship points
 - Disqualification from races
 - Suspension from the series
 - Fines
- C7.4 The above mentioned guidelines will generally be followed and are subject to the Clerk of the Course & Stewards' discretion.

Art. C8 Protests and Appeals

- C8.1 Protests shall be submitted to the (CRO) not later than 20 minutes after the announcing of the heat results.
- C8.2 Protests must be accompanied by a fee of JD50.
- C8.3 The protest fee is not refundable.
- C8.4 Protests can be only be presented by an entrant / driver who took part in the race to which the protest refers to.
- C8.5 Protests must be dealing with a single argument.
- C8.6 The driver may appeal within 30 minutes since the Stewards' decision.
- C8.7 Appeal fee is JD 150.
- C8.8 Appeal fees are only refundable if the stewards gave positive decision to the protestor.
